At Flourish Enterprises we have a number of currently under-utilised areas within our beautiful Grade II listed building and historic gardens which are surrounded by lots of green spaces.

Here at Flourish, everyone is committed to delivering positive social impact and we are looking to do this by working with other not-for-profit services to become a DESTINATION **Wellbeing Hub** that promotes health and happiness, somewhere that provides OPPORTUNITIES for everyone whilst promoting a feeling of TOGETHERNESS.

As part of our work, we would love to open up a number of our assets for other community focussed groups to access and benefit from, completely **free of charge**, with the aim of inviting more people into Woodfield Park to enjoy everything there is to offer both now and still to come.

We recognise that collaborative working will go a long way to making sure our communities get the best experiences whilst allowing more third sector organisations, big and small, to continue to deliver amazing services.

Why co-working?

- Allow for smaller charities to be able to continue delivering vital support and positive social impact until such a time as they are back on sound financial footing;
- Promote greater collaborative working, and support networks sharing best practise, problem solving, and opportunities for joint funding applications;
- Catalyst for new social enterprises to be born using the space as a springboard to launch, learn, collaborate and grow;
- Opportunity to find shared methods of measuring outcomes, and of reporting on the positive social impact of the charitable sector together.

What's the catch?

No catch we promise! We are very fortunate to have some of the best green spaces in Balby and we want to share these with like-minded people like you. We also recognise the value of working together to develop stronger partnerships.

If just one group takes up the offer to use our site in a way that benefits our communities, then for us that is payment enough. The only condition is that the work you do is not for profit and is designed to improve the lives of Doncaster residents.

What can you offer and how can my group access it?

Cherry Tree Court

Cherry Tree Court is the new home of Woodfield24, our specialist palliative care team, which provides end-of-life care for people in the community. The larger space Woodfield 24 now occupies will allow us to establish "Friends of Woodfield24" offering social and emotional support for bereaved families.

We are keen to work closely with others in the charitable sector who share our values and provide beneficial services/support for our community. With this in mind, we are offering free use of our community training and meeting room for up to 4 days per week to charities or community groups that provide complimentary services.

The space includes:

1. Group room – suitable for training or group/social activities suitable up to 15 people. The room features a large screen plasma for presentations and virtual meetings, wall-mounted dry wipe boards and flipcharts, a bank of laptops with Microsoft Office and access to a refreshment area where free hot drinks are available.



Classroom or boardroom style up to 12 people



Theatre style up to 15 people

2. Small meeting room – suitable for therapy sessions or one-to-ones suitable up to 4 people
3. Garden – this space is still being developed (designs attached) suitable up to 20 people

The inside and outside of Cherry Tree Court is nice and peaceful which means it is ideal for smaller groups doing quieter activity.

Cherry Tree Court is available Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday each week from 10am till 4pm. Plus evenings and weekends by special arrangement.

Woodfield Park

The green area surrounding Flourish is called Woodfield Park. The area includes a community hall which is a bookable space (paid for), a gym and squash club, yoga studio and more than 50 office spaces with plenty of free parking. Woodfield Park also features a number of nature trails, cycling and designated running tracks with acres of flat grassed areas suitable for all kinds of activity.

Woodfield Park is a perfect place for all manner of events and whilst it is open to the public, if you would like to carry out any activity, please do speak to us in advance so we can make sure everything runs smoothly for you.

The Walled Gardens

Our Walled Gardens are a beautiful and tranquil space open to the general public between 9am and 4pm daily.

We would love to give more people the opportunity to enjoy spending time in the Walled Gardens. This can be either when the gardens are open to the public on a shared basis or for private exclusive use once the gardens close at 4pm until 8pm. The gardens are perfect for all kinds of activities especially from spring to summer.

We are offering access to the gardens freely to any charitable organisations who will use it to deliver funded/free activities which bring social value to our community. The gardens offer lots of flat hard standing and grassed areas which allows for flexible usage. Inside the Walled Gardens there is also a wonderful log cabin which has a grassed area in front of it. The log cabin is suitable for up to 10 people.

The Walled Gardens are available Monday to Sunday each week from 10am till 4pm on a shared basis followed by exclusive access on evenings until 7pm. Later opening and weekends by special arrangement.



Discount For Larger Rooms

Alongside the free-to-access spaces we now offer a generous discount for hire of the 3 larger function spaces in the main house. You can choose to hold your event in The Drawing Room, The Dining Room and The Library.

Flourish will exclusively offer 50% off the normal rate to organisations that provide third sector services across the borough. With the discount applied the cost to hire a single function room is now £65 for a half day and £97.50 for a full day hire. This will include the usual set up and equipment but will not include any form of catering. Catering can be purchased from the café or booked in advance at the normal prices.

When making an enquiry or confirming a booking please be aware that:

- Bookings and payment are done via our front of house team;
- Bookings that qualify for 50% discount can be made up to 8 weeks in advance;
- Half day hire option is for 4 hours with a choice of the **AM Slot** 8.30am till 12.30 or the **PM Slot** 1pm till 5pm. Any times that straddle the AM and PM slots would be charged at the discounted day rate of £97.50.

Charity Hive (C:HIVE) Co-Working Space

We currently have a large vacant room in St Catherine's House which we propose to transform into a co-working facility that would be available free of charge to charitable organisations in Doncaster, up until Summer 2022 (qualifying criteria may apply).

This proposal follows a number of conversations with smaller, local charitable organisations, whose activities, vital social impact and very survival are at risk due to the ongoing impact of covid19. We believe the current vacancy at St Catherine's House creates an opportunity, and a responsibility, for us support these groups. The space will include a fully furnished open plan office, storage and printing, reception desk and meeting rooms with convenient access to our café and gardens. C:HIVE will provide all the ingredients for existing and new social enterprises to **Launch, Learn, Collaborate** and **Grow**.

We are now awaiting confirmation of whether a funding application has been successful but, in the meantime, we are inviting any expressions of interest using the contact details below.
